



STUDENT BILL OF RIGHTS

Students have the right to:

1. Attend school and participate in school programs when appropriate.
2. Have a safe, healthy, orderly, and courteous school environment that fosters student achievement and academic excellence.
3. Ask questions when they don't understand.
4. Dress appropriately.
5. Seek help in solving problems.
6. Take part in all district activities on an equal basis regardless of race, color, creed, national origin, religion, gender, sexual orientation, or disability, or any other categories of individuals protected against discrimination by federal, state, or local law.
7. Be respected by one another and staff and treat others fairly in accordance with the District Code of Conduct and the provisions of DASA. To conduct themselves in a manner that fosters an environment that is free from intimidation, harassment, discrimination and/or retaliation.
8. To report and encourage others to report any incidents of intimidation, harassment, discrimination and/or retaliation.
9. Present their version of the relevant events to school personnel.
10. Access school rules and, when necessary, receive an explanation of those rules from school personnel.
