# WHAT ARE SOME OF THE BIGGEST DIFFERENCES?

- The workload can be greater/more challenging.
- Grades towards GPA and post-high school plans start now.
- Plan on at least 1.5 to 2 hours of homework/studying per night.
- Students should be doing homework the night that it is assigned.
- Don't be afraid to ask for help. It is all manageable if you stay on top of it. There is always work to be done.
- Minimum grade to pass a class is 65%. There is no promotion to the next course level without passing the current class for high school credit.

## COURSE SELECTION PROCESS

- Meet with School Counselor Mrs. Paterson to complete the course selection form.
- Teachers are making recommendations for next year classes.
- After meeting with the school counselor, the student will bring home course selection form to be signed by a parent/guardian.
- The signed course selection form needs to be returned to the school counseling office.
