




TOP 5 VALUE WORDS OF ALL GROUPS-COMBINED

DATA OBSERVATIONS

- Achievement and Learning was strongly #1
- After that: Communication/ Collaboration,
 Fostering Relationships, High Expectations,
 Honesty/ Integrity, Diversity/Inclusivity,
 Community, Respect/Dignity, and Trust "tied"

RANKING CORE VALUE STATEMENTS-COLOR CODING

- 1. Green type means that the that the statement was ranked "most important" or "important"
- 2. Black type means that the statement was ranked "important"
- 3. Red type means that the response received more "not important" or "somewhat important" rankings than other statements
