Rapid Tests received from NYS Re:

Hello APW families!

I hope everyone enjoyed the holidays!

Yesterday, APW received test kits from NYS. We have been instructed to use the test kits in the following ways:

- 1. Use tests for Test-to-Stay in School method
- 2. Give one box (two kits per box) to each student enrolled in school

We did not receive enough test kits to supply every student with a kit, therefore we will be using the kits for #1 The Test-to-Stay in School method.

Test-to-Stay in School method

Use the kits for students who have been a close contact of a COVID positive case – in school but show no symptoms of COVID.

This will greatly reduce the number of students that need to stay out of school for 10 days simply because they were designated as a close contact in school by the Health Department. The protocol for Test-to-Stay in School requires the student to be tested three (3) times over a seven day period. Students who are in the Test-to-Stay in School protocol are allowed to ride the school bus. Parents who give us permission can have their student tested before the school day begins; negative results allow the student to stay in school that day and until the next test. If a student tests positive, parents will be required to pick their student up and keep him/her quarantined per Health Department Guidance.

We will begin the Test-to-Stay in School on Monday, January 10, 2022. If you receive word from the school that your child has been quarantined due to a contact in school – you can arrange with your school nurse to have your child tested throughout the quarantine period to stay in school.
