Re: Spectators at sporting events

With a decrease in new COVID cases in Oswego County over the past month, the Oswego County Health Department has revised its policy for “higher risk” sports in schools and youth recreation leagues.

As of March 3, 2021, Oswego County schools and leagues will be allowed to admit spectators under the following guidelines:

1. **Only Home Team** spectators will be admitted;
2. **Two** home team spectators per athlete;
3. Spectators must **wear masks** at all times;
4. Spectators who are not from the same household must be **socially distanced by 6 feet** at all times.
5. All previous guidance for sports and recreational activities must be followed.

School districts and youth sports leagues must follow the New York State “Interim Guidance for Sports and Recreation during the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency” which include the following guidelines:

Spectators will be asked to answer screening questions upon entering the building, as well as have their temperature checked. Anyone who is experiencing symptoms of COVID 19 will not be allowed to enter the building.

Each Rebel athlete will receive two (2) passes to be distributed as their family sees fit. Our Athletic Coordinator, Scott Stanard, has been working on logistical plans for home Basketball games in the event we received this news! We are ready to receive Rebel Fans beginning at the Boys’ Basketball game(s) on Thursday, March 3rd!

We look forward to a time when we can welcome all Rebel Fans back to our gym and fields. At this time, we find it imperative that we (and you) follow these guidelines so our athletes can enjoy hearing their families cheer for them.
