**Title I**  
**\$546,316**

- Elementary Social Worker

**Title II**  
**\$43,164**

- Mentoring for all teachers in years 1-4 of career (includes stipend for mentors)
- Selected Professional Texts aligned to Strategic Plan and Professional Development Plan
- Curriculum Alignment Hourly Pay for Participating Faculty

**Title IV**  
**\$41,827**

- Minimum of 20% of funds must be used for Well-Rounded Education -- Focus is on SEL Skills and Teach Like a Champion Instructional Strategies
- Minimum of 20% of funds must be used for Safe and Healthy Students – Summer Programming
- A portion of the remaining must focus on the Effective Use of Technology – Technology PD and Equipment

- Funding is based on the economic status of students attending APW schools.
- The purpose of the funding is to support school improvement efforts.
