We are creating an *Evening Virtual Tutoring Program* to provide students with extra academic support. The program will run Monday through Thursday (6:00pm-8:00pm) on days that school is in session, and we will staff the program with a rotation of different content area teachers each night. Students can “drop-in” to the virtual classroom to receive academic assistance from teachers. More details will be communicated to you and students in the coming weeks about this new program.
