Ensuring interventions address the disproportionate impact of the coronavirus on target groups of students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• School Based Leadership Teams (SBLTs) will set goals and action steps related to the impact of lost instructional time</li> <li>• SBLTs will meet at least four times per year to analyze progress toward goals</li> <li>• SBLTs will work with grade-level and content-area teams, along with the MTSS and Student Support Teams to meet the needs of all learners</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The District's ARP Plan must be reviewed every 6 months through 9/2023.</li> <li>• The District must submit a Final Program Report to ensure accountability and transparency.</li> </ul>
